At the Proverse Spring Reception, 9 April 2015, held in Central Hong Kong, six books were launched:

- *Alphabet* (Andrew S. Guthrie's poetry collection on aspects of literacy and illiteracy.)
- *Bright Lights and White Nights* (Debut novel by Andrew Carter. A young man's experience of living and working in Hong Kong.)
- *Cop Show Heaven* (Novel by Lawrence Gray: an allegory of the return of Hong Kong to the Mainland.)
- *Poems to Enjoy, Book 5* (The long-awaited final book in Verner Bickley's poetry anthology for students, teachers and parents, 3rd edition.)
- *The Devil You Know* (Peter Gregoire's second Scott Lee mystery novel, set against the backdrop of the Hong Kong Chief Executive election of 2017.)
- *Tiger Autumn* (Jan Pearson's second thriller set in 1960s Hong Kong / China. -- The Kowloon Walled City and the Hei Ling Chau leper colony, now closed, feature in the setting.)
